Connect with other talented cellists from all over Europe and, together, feel your inspiration reawakened amongst an unforgettable alpine scenery and the unique educational ethos of Scandinavian Cello School.

Second call - 7 day residential masterclass

Date of residency: 7th April - 14th April 2025

100% Scholarship for Tuition: 5 lessons are included, plus group classes & other activities Including 2 lessons with Prof. Jacob Shaw & 3 lessons with Johannes Gray

Full board and lodging fee: 750 euro

Some part-scholarships & full scholarships for accommodation are available! Please include an additional letter explaining why you need a scholarship.

Includes pick up/drop off from Malesco station (exact arrival time tbc after acceptance to Alpine Cello Academy). Breakfast, lunch and dinner (including refreshments) is served at the location.

Accommodation is simple single or double rooms, with ample space for practicing provided.

Additionally, the hosting location offers you an option of prolonging your stay after the masterclass in a form of artistic retreat. **Please indicate in your application whether you would like to benefit from this opportunity.** Costs of such a retreat are calculated individually.
